WORKER TRAINING SUBSIDY

DISTRIBUTION GUIDELINES

Worker Training Subsidy will be distributed on an annual basis among St. Matthew's students who attend one of the WELS Ministerial Education Schools, Luther Preparatory School, Martin Luther College and Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary. The Worker Training Subsidy check will be made payable both to the student and the parents requesting the subsidy. The following guidelines will be followed.

1. No student will receive more than ½ of their overall tuition costs. No student is guaranteed that ½ of their tuition costs, or any other amount, will be covered.
2. A student wishing to receive the Worker Training Subsidy from St. Matthew's must fill out a simple payment form and indicate the amount of tuition and fees they are obligated to pay, net of the total amount of financial aid anticipated from any other source. No student will receive Worker Training Subsidy equal to more than one half of the amount applied for in any given school year.
3. Any student that is expelled from school for disciplinary reasons will reimburse St. Matthew's for any Worker Training Subsidy received during that school year.
4. If the total of one half of the amount applied for in a given year is more than the amount of the funds to be distributed, then a proportionate share of the difference will be deducted from the amounts to be given to each student requesting the subsidy.
5. If the total of one half of the amount applied for in a given year is less than the amount of the funds available to be distributed, then the remaining unused Worker Training Subsidy will be paid to the synod against the WELS Mission account.
6. Payment forms must be submitted to the Pastor or Business Administrator no later than September 30th of the school year.
7. The subsidy payments will be determined and authorized at the following January church council meeting based on the Treasurer's report balance for Worker Training Subsidy as of the year end on December 31st.
8. If a student has an outstanding balance of education fees due and payable to St. Matthew's Lutheran School, they will not be eligible to receive Worker Training Subsidy.
