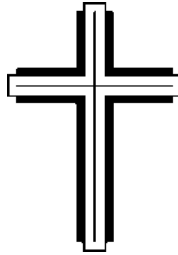

Network System Specialist (replacement position)

This full-time role provides support and troubleshoots the campus network infrastructure and is primarily responsible for delivering network support for all facets of the WLC campus. This objective is achieved by the performance of tasks which include but are not limited to:

- Manage the Cisco routers, switches, firewall, wireless LAN controllers, servers, wireless access points, wireless bridges and CheckPoint firewall ensuring maximum up-time.
- Administer and maintain the telephone and voicemail system on campus.
- Provide day-to-day tier three support to the Help Desk.

Key Requirements include but are not limited to:

Associate's or bachelor's degree in network operations or related information technology discipline. Minimum of 1 year of successful professional experience in an IT operations role required. In lieu of degree a combination of technical training and experience may be considered. Cisco Certified Network Associate certification and/or Microsoft certification, preferred. Must have proven ability to install, configure and troubleshoot software, hardware, end-user networking and peripheral equipment. Must be able to maintain 24/7 network and work on call, if needed, after hours including nights and weekends.
