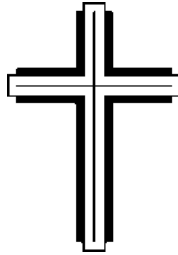


St. Matthew's Announcements May 23, 2010

ONLY ONE BUS IS GOING – approximately 8 seats are left – sign up now! If the bus is full continue to sign up in case we have cancellations. If we get an additional 40 people to sign up, we will consider getting the second bus again.

Cost is \$25 per person for the \$20 ticket and \$5 bus ride – money is not due until May 31st.
