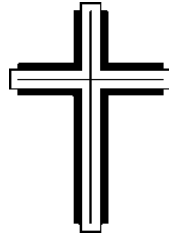


St. Matthew's Announcements

This blood drive will be held in the Mobile Unit from the Blood Center of Wisconsin, which will be parked in the church parking lot. Because the Blood Center needs a facility where the temperature is cool for the medical equipment, due to the summer temperatures and the fact that our school gym is not air conditioned, the Blood Center will use the mobile unit as we did the last two summers. The drive will be doing regular blood donations. They will not be doing platelets or red cell donations. We have just been notified that we have qualified to participate in the "Summer Scholarship Blood Drive". When you donate, you will be given the opportunity to win a scholarship to the college of your choice from BloodCenter of Wisconsin. Community members, including teachers, families and friends can donate on behalf of an eligible student to increase student's chances to be awarded a scholarship.
