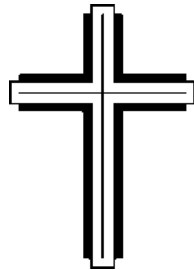


## St. Matthew's Announcements

St. Matthew's Church will be sponsoring a community blood drive on Wednesday, August 11th. This blood drive will be held in the Mobile Unit from the Blood Center of Wisconsin, which will be parked in the church parking lot. Because the Blood Center needs a facility where the temperature is cool for the medical equipment, due to the summer temperatures and the fact that our school gym is not air conditioned, the Blood Center will use the mobile unit as we did the last two summers. This drive will be doing regular blood donations. No platelet or red cell donations will be taken. We have been notified that we have qualified to participate in the "Summer Scholarship Blood Drive". When you donate, you will be given the opportunity to win a scholarship to the college of your choice from BloodCenter of Wisconsin. Community members, including teachers, families and friends can donate on behalf of an eligible student to increase the student's chances to be awarded a scholarship. When you donate, if you do not have a designated choice of a scholarship recipient, we can give you names of college students from our congregation. Our members and friends in the community have been amazing in repeatedly coming to donate at our blood drives. However, people have surgeries, donate at work, and move out of our area. Therefore, we are constantly looking for new donors. Won't you consider donating?
